Pradeep won the first 2 games with ease but Sandeep Gambhir comeback strongly to win the 3rd game but eventually Pradeep defeated Sandeep to level the score after 2 matches. Doubles was the key to championship and once again Pradeep & Vikas displayed fantastic combination between them to defeat Sandeep & Abhishek with the score of (3-1) in best of 5 games. Brimming with confidence after winning the doubles Pradeep defeated Abhishek in straight sets to win the tournament for second time in a row.
